RSNA[®] Journals Rated by the Australian Research Council

Experts evaluate 20,712 journals, assigning *Radiology* & *RadioGraphics* among best.

(OAK BROOK, ILL.) March 2, 2010 –RSNA’s two peer-reviewed journals, *Radiology* and *RadioGraphics*, have been included in the Australian Research Council’s report assessing research quality within Australia’s higher education institutions.

RadioGraphics received a solid rating of “B” while *Radiology* was rated an “A*” indicating “one of the best in its field.”
