MEETING FACTS

(as of 10/19/07)

The Scientific Assembly and Annual Meeting of the Radiological Society of North America (RSNA®) is the world's largest international medical meeting. The meeting is a premier event for physicians sharing medical knowledge with one another.

Facts about the meeting include:

- Six days of educational programs for radiologists, radiation oncologists, physicists in medicine and allied health care professionals;
- Professional registration is up 4% compared with 2006; total number of attendees pre-registered for RSNA 2007 is up 3% compared with 2006;
- For RSNA 2007, the society has secured more than 100,000 room nights at 70 downtown Chicago hotels;
- Spouse/guest pre-registration is up 1% compared with last year's level;
- Total square footage of exhibit space is 3% above last year's total of 519,900 square feet;
- 758 technical exhibits will occupy 535,300 square feet;
- 122 (16%) of the exhibitors are first-time exhibitors at RSNA;
- Attendees will contribute nearly \$128 million to Chicago's economy;
- 1,765 scientific papers in 16 subspecialties: breast imaging; cardiac; chest; emergency radiology; gastrointestinal; genitourinary; health services, policy and research; molecular imaging; musculoskeletal; neuroradiology/head and neck; nuclear medicine; pediatric; physics; radiation oncology and radiobiology; informatics; and vascular and interventional;
- More than 257 refresher courses and 83 multisessions;
- 1,498 education exhibits and 604 scientific posters will be featured in the Lakeside Learning Center.
