**MEETING FACTS**

(as of 10/11/06)

The Scientific Assembly and Annual Meeting of the Radiological Society of North America (RSNA®) is the world's largest international medical meeting. The meeting is a premier event for physicians sharing medical knowledge with one another.

Facts about the meeting include:

- Six days of educational programs for radiologists, radiation oncologists, physicists in medicine and allied health care professionals;
- Professional registration is up 3% compared with 2005; total number of attendees pre-registered for RSNA 2006 is up 2% compared with 2005;
- For RSNA 2006, the society has secured more than 100,000 room nights at 69 downtown Chicago hotels;
- Spouse/guest pre-registration is up 2% compared with last year's level;
- Total square footage of exhibit space is 6% above last year's totals;
- 738 technical exhibits occupying 514,800 square feet;
- 144 (20%) of the exhibitors are first-time exhibitors at RSNA;
- Attendees will contribute nearly \$116 million to Chicago's economy;
- 1,625 scientific papers in 17 subspecialties: breast; cardiac; chest; emergency; gastrointestinal; genitourinary; health services, policy and research; molecular imaging; musculoskeletal; neuroradiology/head and neck; nuclear medicine; pediatrics; physics; radiation oncology and radiobiology; radiology informatics; ultrasound; vascular and interventional;
- More than 300 refresher courses;
- 1,428 education exhibits and 638 scientific posters covering 17 subspecialties will be featured in the Lakeside Learning Center.
