RSNA FACTS

- RSNA® has more than 40,000 members in 116 countries.
- More than 62,000 people attended the 2005 RSNA Scientific Assembly and Annual Meeting, including more than 26,000 professionals from 100 countries. The scientific assembly is the largest annual medical meeting in the world. It has been held consecutively in Chicago since 1985. McCormick Place was first used in 1975.
- Full RSNA members in North America pay 2007 dues of \$355 annually. Membership benefits in 2006 are worth at least \$1,015 (\$570 for annual meeting with advance registration, \$275 for *Radiology*, \$150 for *RadioGraphics*, \$20 for *RSNA News*—value based on nonmember subscription rates). They also receive 20% off RSNA educational materials, free access to CME credit on InteractED®, RSNA CME Repository, free access to online RSNA journals and many indirect benefits.
- RSNA publishes two peer-reviewed medical journals:

- Print and online circulation is 42,469 for *Radiology*, 39,634 for *RadioGraphics* and 38,800 for *RSNA News*.
- In 2005, the total CME credit hours earned from *RadioGraphics* was 63,168. Since 1990, 436,035 credits have been awarded.
- InteractED offers more than 300 CME programs.
- Since its inception in July 2000, InteractED has issued more than 237,046 CME certificates. (As of July 1, 2006)
- Since 1984, the RSNA Research & Education Foundation provided more than \$24 million in grant support to fund 590 education and research programs.
- The RSNA Board of Directors has eight members, each serving a six-year term.
- RSNA employs 150 people.
- RSNA headquarters, located at 820 Jorie Blvd. in Oak Brook, Ill., opened in October 1998.
