A 1^{1/2}-day workshop is planned for October 23-24, 2009 at the RSNA Headquarters in Oak Brook, Illinois for representatives from departments of radiology, radiation oncology, and nuclear medicine. The program will focus on strategies for developing and expanding research programs in radiology and radiation oncology departments. A combination of presentations, case studies, and group discussions will be used.

The purpose of this program is to:

Nurture radiology cultures that highly value research

Educate radiology department leaders in how to develop research programs

Educate radiology leaders in methods that will identify, develop, mentor and reward radiologic and radiation oncologic scientists for research in imaging and image-guided therapy

Focus on topics that are of generalized interest, but to be especially directed towards academic radiology departments that are not currently in the top tier relative to existing extramural funding.

- **Radiology Research Training**
- **Case Presentations of Research Program Initiatives: Impact of Internal and External Reviews**
- **Funding Sources**
