## **NIH GRANTSMANSHIP WORKSHOP**

The Radiological Society of North America is sponsoring a four-hour NIH Grantsmanship Workshop, the goal of which is to provide participants with an introduction to writing a grant proposal for the National Institutes of Health (NIH), specifically relating to the radiologic sciences. The workshop is primarily intended for junior faculty in academic centers who wish to pursue a career in radiologic research. Participants will have the opportunity to experience a mock study section.

Lee Rosen, Ph.D., from the Center for Scientific Review at NIH, will facilitate the workshop and will be joined by two or three imaging scientists who have proven track records in grantsmanship and the review process.

- Understand the granting process at NIH.
- Prepare an NIH grant application.
- Plan appropriate research consistent with NIH procedures.
- Summarize the details of the peer-review system.
- Gain insights into study section review of grant applications.
