September is Prostate Cancer Awareness Month.

Prostate cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death in American men. While African-American men are at much higher risk, men over 65 and those with a family history of the disease also are at risk.

Early prostate cancer often shows no symptoms. If you have concerns about prostate cancer, ask your doctor about available diagnostic tests and whether they're right for you. Your age, general health and the stage of the cancer will determine your treatment options.
