### **Interpreting Room Numbers**

- The first letter in the meeting room number—N, S, E, W—stands for the North, South, East (also called Lakeside Center East) or West Building.
- The first digit of the meeting room number—1, 2, 3, 4, 5—is the building level number.
- The last two digits specify the exact room number.
- Some meeting rooms have divider walls, which create smaller spaces. These will have an A, B, C or D following the room number.

*Example: N227 = North Building, Level 2, Room 27*

## SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT COVID-19 HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

### YOUR SAFETY IS OUR PRIORITY

RSNA is partnering with the Chicago Department of Public Health to provide a safe meeting and trusts that all participants will help support this effort. We require proof of full vaccination from all meeting attendees, RSNA staff, labor and exhibitor personnel prior to the meeting or upon admittance to McCormick Place.

Face masks are required in all public indoor spaces, including RSNA-provided shuttle buses, Metra trains, rideshares, etc., regardless of the status of mask mandates outside of RSNA 2021. ## Claiming Credit at RSNA 2021

### Continuing Medical Education (CME) Documentation

During the week of the live meeting, sessions viewed virtually and sessions into which in-person attendees scan will be automatically added to their attendance record within 24 hours after the session. Visit *Meeting.RSNA.org* to access the credit claiming site to search, select and evaluate your own sessions and to adjust the time spent in each session.

Transcripts may only be adjusted until April 30, 2022, when virtual access ends. Attendees will maintain access to the credit claiming site through April 30, 2023, in order to print their certificate and/or record of attendance.

### Continuing Education (CE) Documentation (ARRT)

In order to record and obtain Category A+ continuing education (CE) credits, all ARRT-registered radiologic technologists and radiologist assistants must follow ARRT guidelines. Failure to do so will result in no credits being awarded.

- ARRT requires that all registrants seeking Category A+ credit must be present and attentive for 50 minutes of every scheduled hour of a live CE activity. If you arrive late, leave early or slip out of the meeting room for a break, that time is deducted from your attendance.
- ARRT registrants will be required to scan their badge in and out of each educational session. Registrants will not receive ARRT credit for the session if they do not scan their badge in and out of the session.
- Sessions will be automatically added to their attendee record within 24 hours of the event.
- Partial credit is not available to ARRT attendees.
- In addition to ARRT requirements, you must evaluate your RSNA 2021 courses online at *Meeting.RSNA.org*.
- In mid-December, RSNA will email certificates to ARRT-registered radiologic technologists and radiologist assistants who requested a certificate during registration and followed these ARRT guidelines.

Museum Campus/11<sup>th</sup> Street station is on Michigan Avenue at 11<sup>th</sup> Street with street access on the east side of Michigan Avenue on the 11<sup>th</sup> Street bridge.

The station within McCormick Place is underground and accessible from the west side of the Grand Concourse—Level 2.5. Look for the Metra Information Desk near the entrance.
