Interpreting Room Numbers

- The first letter in the meeting room number—N, S, E, W—stands for the North, South, East (also called Lakeside Center East) or West Building.
- The first digit of the meeting room number—1,2,3,4,5—is the building level number.
- The last two digits specify the exact room number.
- Some meeting rooms have divider walls, which create smaller spaces. These will have an A, B, C or D following the room number.



Claiming Credit at RSNA 2023

Continuing Medical Education (CME) Documentation

During the week of the live meeting, sessions viewed virtually or sessions attended in person and documented by scanning your badge will be automatically added to your attendance record within 24 hours after the session. Visit Meeting Central or the meeting app to access the credit claiming site to search, select and evaluate your own sessions and to adjust the time spent in each session. Sessions where you weren't able to get scanned can be manually added.

To simplify your credit claiming process, make sure your badge is scanned before entering a session room to ensure your attendance is documented and automatically added to the credit claiming site within 24 hours after the session.

Note: Scanning upon entering a session does not guarantee the session has CME. Check each session in the meeting program on Meeting Central to determine if CME is offered.

Transcripts may only be adjusted until April 30, 2024, noon CT, when Virtual Access ends. You will maintain access to the credit claiming site until April 30, 2025, in order to print your certificate and/or record of attendance.

Staff will be available at Meeting Information & Member Services to assist with claiming credits. Please visit Meeting Central or the meeting app for additional details.

Continuing Education (CE) Documentation (ARRT)

In order to record and obtain Category A+ continuing education (CE) credits, all ARRT-registered radiologic technologists and radiologist assistants must follow ARRT guidelines. Failure to do so will result in no credits being awarded.

- ARRT requires that all registrants seeking Category A+ credit must be present and attentive for 50 minutes of every scheduled hour of a live CE activity. If you arrive late, leave early or slip out of the meeting room for a break, that time is deducted from your attendance.
- ARRT registrants will be required to scan their badge in and out of each educational session. Registrants will not receive ARRT credit for the session if they do not scan their badge in and out of the session.
- Sessions will be automatically added to their attendee record within 24 hours of the event.
- Partial credit is not available to ARRT attendees.
- In addition to ARRT requirements, you must evaluate your RSNA 2023 courses online at Meeting Central or in the meeting app.
- In mid-December, RSNA will email certificates to ARRT-registered radiologic technologists and radiologist assistants who requested a certificate during registration and followed these ARRT guidelines.



McCormick Place Parking

There are two main parking lots at McCormick Place. They are within walking distance and ADA accessible.

McCormick Place parking garages do not offer in-and-out privileges.

For parking at the North and South Buildings, use Lot A, also known as Martin Luther King Self Park/MLK, located at 2301 S. Prairie Ave. Lot A is automated and open 24/7. The parking rate is \$25 for up to 16 hours and \$38 for 16–24 hours.

For parking at the Lakeside Center East, use Lot C, also known as Lakeside Garage, located on Fort Dearborn Dr. The parking rate is \$25/day.







Chicago’s rail system consists of train lines spanning the city and is known as the “L”, short for “elevated” train. In many parts of the world, this system is also referred to as a “subway” or “metro”. The Cermak-McCormick Place Green Line Station offers attendees an additional way to leave the McCormick Place campus with stops convenient for those staying in hotels south of the Chicago River. The Cermak-McCormick Place Green Line Station is located at 12 E. Cermak Rd. (between State St. and Wabash Ave.), two blocks northwest of the West Building, Gate 41.
