

RSNA 2025 Technical Exhibits Priority Point System

A priority point system has been developed to recognize a company's support of RSNA and reward exhibitors for upholding meeting policies during their previous exhibit participation. RSNA 2024 contracted exhibitors earn points throughout the year and will have the opportunity to select their booth position during RSNA 2024 for the next year's annual meeting that takes place December 1-4, 2025.

The order of space selection is determined by each exhibitor's cumulative number of points, via the following criteria, as of October 31, 2024:

- Four (4) historical points for each year of participation as an RSNA technical exhibitor at the last 20 annual meetings (since 2005).
- Two (2) early hotel reservation points for reserving RSNA 2024 hotel rooms through the RSNA hotel reservation system by Friday, December 2, 2023.
- Three (3) hotel reservation points for reserving RSNA 2024 hotel rooms through the RSNA hotel reservation system by October 31, 2024.
- Two (2) payment points for adhering to and completing each exhibit space payment installation on or before the published date.
 - Two (2) points earned for paying 25% deposit in full on or before January 1, 2024
 - Two (2) points earned for paying second 25% payment on or before April 1, 2024
 - Two (2) points earned for final payment made on or before July 1, 2024
 - Two (2) points earned for new exhibit contracts received with full payment after July 1, 2024
- One (1) Corporate Partners point for every \$1,000 spent on RSNA's Corporate Partners program initiatives between November 1, 2023 and October 31, 2024. This program recognizes investments made in meeting sponsorships, year-round promotions, R&E Foundation donations, subscriptions and more.
- One (1) booth size point for each 100 square feet of paid exhibit space at RSNA 2024.
- One (1) ancillary space point for each Headquarter Office and Meeting Suite rental at RSNA 2024.

Exhibitors will be ranked based on cumulative priority points earned using the above point system. Tie-breaker procedures will be enforced when multiple companies have earned the same number of priority points. The tied companies' points will be analyzed in the following order until one organization clearly outranks the other(s). The sequence for analysis will be: (1) historical points, (2) early hotel reservations points, (3) hotel reservations, (4) payment points, (5) Corporate Partners points, (6) booth size points, (7) ancillary space points and (8) alphabetical order of contracted company name - Z-A in odd years and A-Z in even years.

Mergers

When exhibitors have merged with, have been purchased by, or have purchased another company; provided that only one company continues to exhibit, the most favorable priority points earned by a single company, among all companies involved, will apply. If a division or subsidiary of an exhibitor chooses to exhibit separately, they will be subject to the guidelines on company subsidiaries or company divisions.

During subsequent years of participation, the most favorable historical points earned by a single company among all companies involved, will be the prevailing number of historical points considered for the merged company.

RSNA Exhibition Services must be notified of any mergers no later than October 31, 2024, for consideration during the RSNA 2025 Space Selection Process. After the merger/acquisition, if a company exhibits in multiple booths, Company Subsidiaries and Divisions guidelines will apply.

Company Divisions

An exhibiting company participating with multiple, uniquely named exhibit spaces representing different divisions of the company, will complete a separate Technical Exhibits Space Application/Contract for each division. If all exhibit spaces are under the same name, a single Technical Exhibits Space Application/Contract will include all spaces secured. The primary exhibitor will earn one set of points. All points for each division's exhibit spaces will be counted toward the primary exhibitor's point total and will be invited to one space selection appointment. Divisions exhibiting separately that wish to have their own set of points and separate space selection appointments must notify RSNA Exhibition Services by emailing exhibits@rsna.org no later than October 31, 2024.

Company Subsidiaries

Subsidiaries of an exhibiting company participating with their own exhibit space would complete a separate Technical Exhibits Space Application/Contract, earn its own set of exhibitor priority points, and select space according to the Technical Exhibit Priority Point System.

Co-located Booths

If two or more exhibiting companies wish to be located next to each other in the Technical Exhibits, all involved companies must notify RSNA Exhibition Services in writing via email from a company email account or on company letterhead no later than October 31, 2024. Points of all companies wishing to be located next to each other will be averaged to determine the order of their collective exhibit space selection appointment. Each exhibiting company would maintain their own company identity.

Company Name Change

If a company name changes since its most recent participation, please indicate the previous company name on the application to be properly awarded historical points. If a name change occurs after the space application process, please notify RSNA Exhibition Services by emailing exhibits@rsna.org.

Penalties

The RSNA Technical Exhibits Rules and Regulations serve to protect the integrity of the exhibition; ensure compliance with laws, codes, ordinances, and contracts with the exhibition facility and ensure all exhibitors are treated fairly. If an exhibitor fails to comply with these rules and regulations, the exhibitor may be penalized, including loss of points, being charged a higher exhibit space rental rate, and/or assessed a penalty fee.
