## Interpreting Room Numbers

- The first letter in the meeting room number—N, S, E, W—stands for the North, South, East (also called Lakeside Center East) or West Building.
- The first digit of the meeting room number—1,2,3,4,5—is the building level number.
- The last two digits specify the exact room number.
- Some meeting rooms have divider walls, which create smaller spaces. These will have an A,B,C or D following the room number.

**Example N227 = North Building, Level 2, Room 27**

## Claiming Credit at RSNA 2022

### Continuing Medical Education (CME) Documentation

During the week of the live meeting, sessions viewed virtually and sessions into which in-person attendees scan will be automatically added to their attendance record within 24 hours after the session. Visit Meeting Central at [Meeting.RSNA.org](http://Meeting.RSNA.org) to access the credit claiming site to search, select and evaluate your own sessions and to adjust the time spent in each session.

Transcripts may only be adjusted until May 1, 2023, noon CT, when virtual access ends. Attendees will maintain access to the credit claiming site through May 1, 2024, in order to print their certificate and/or record of attendance.

### Continuing Education (CE) Documentation (ARRT)

In order to record and obtain Category A+ continuing education (CE) credits, all ARRT-registered radiologic technologists and radiologist assistants must follow ARRT guidelines. Failure to do so will result in no credits being awarded.

- ARRT requires that all registrants seeking Category A+ credit must be present and attentive for 50 minutes of every scheduled hour of a live CE activity. If you arrive late, leave early or slip out of the meeting room for a break, that time is deducted from your attendance.
- ARRT registrants will be required to scan their badge in and out of each educational session. Registrants will not receive ARRT credit for the session if they do not scan their badge in and out of the session.

- Sessions will be automatically added to their attendee record within 24 hours of the event.
- Partial credit is not available to ARRT attendees.
- In addition to ARRT requirements, you must evaluate your RSNA 2022 courses online at Meeting Central.
- In mid-December, RSNA will email certificates to ARRT-registered radiologic technologists and radiologist assistants who requested a certificate during registration and followed these ARRT guidelines.

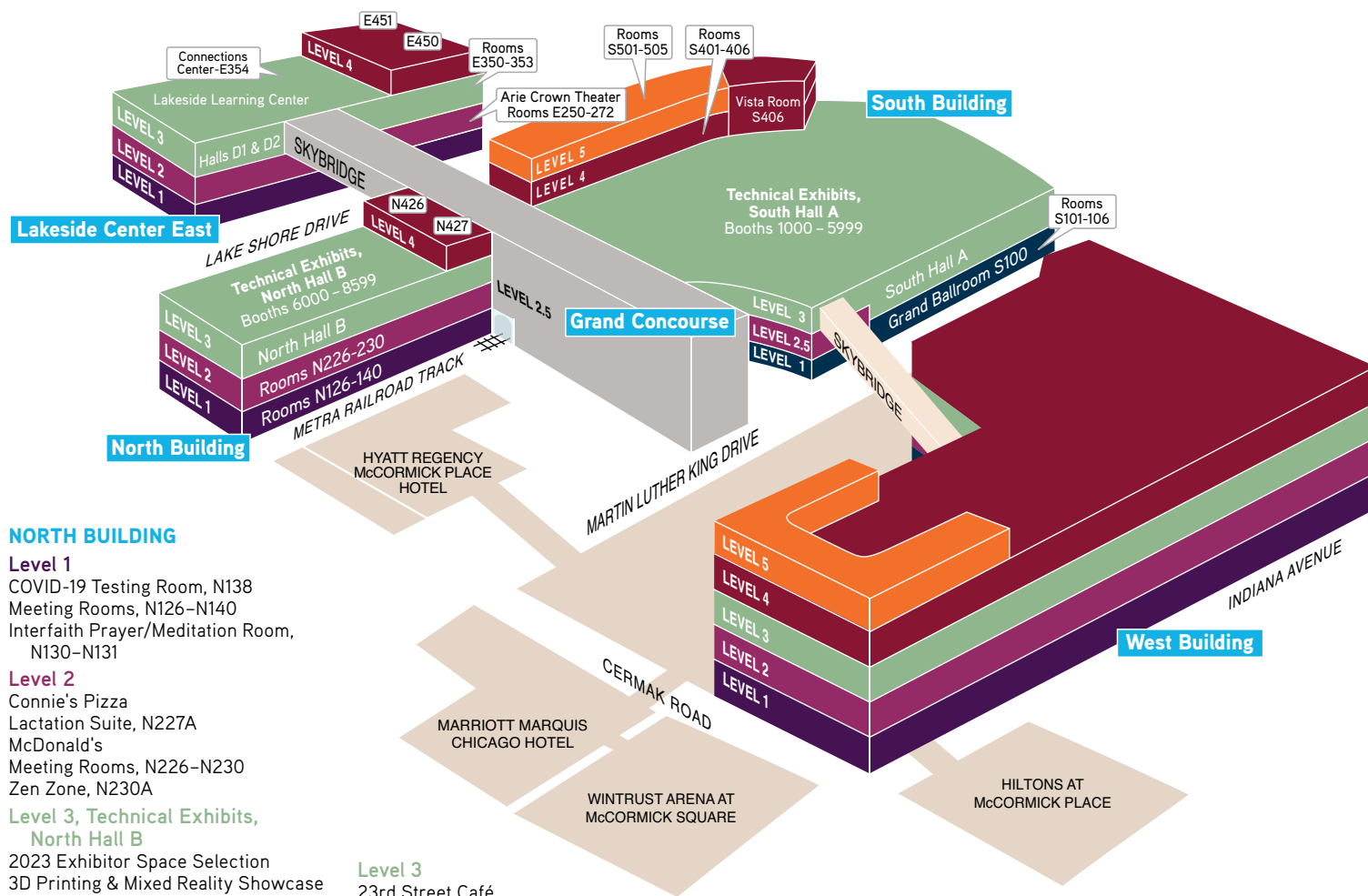

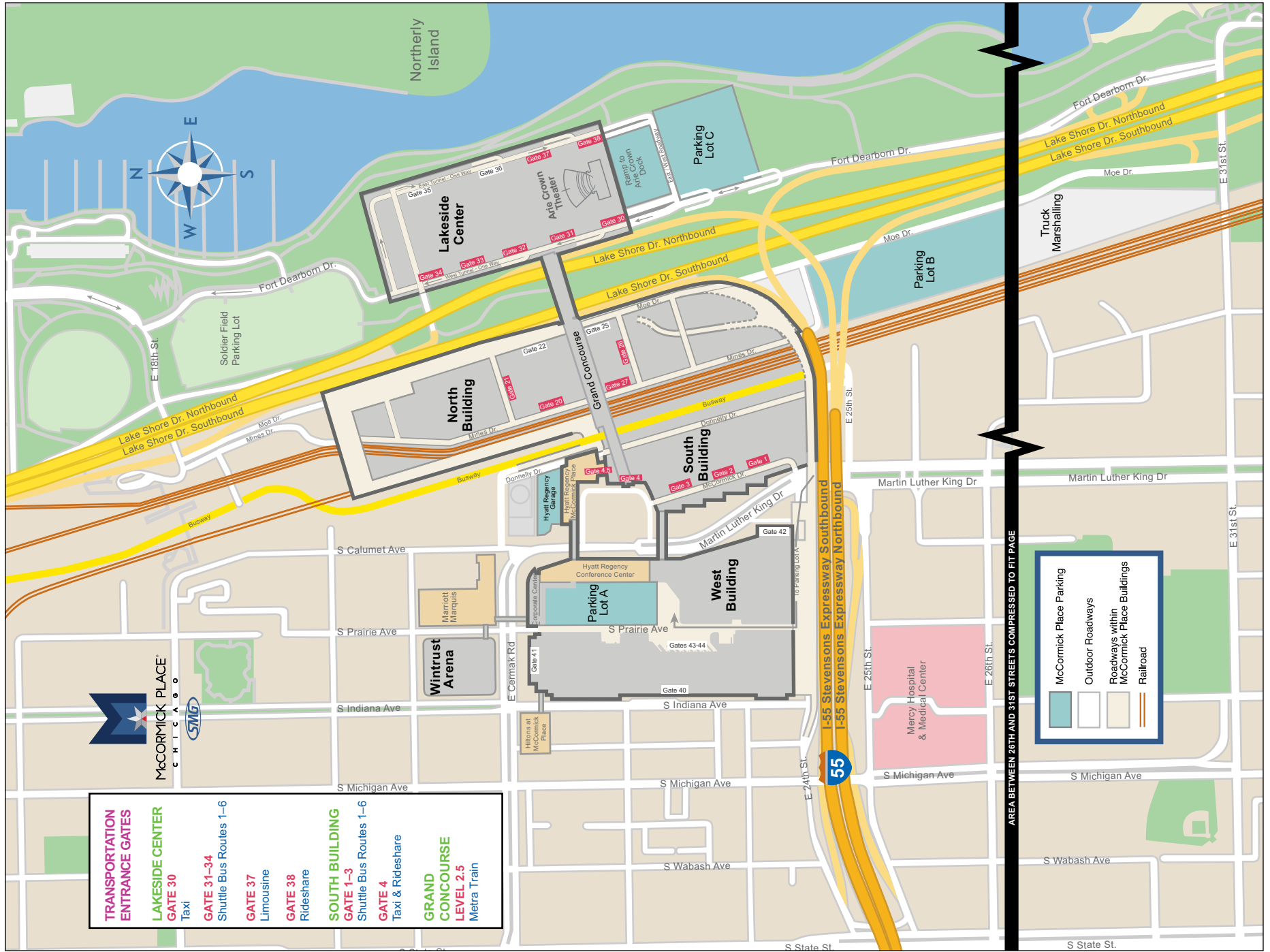

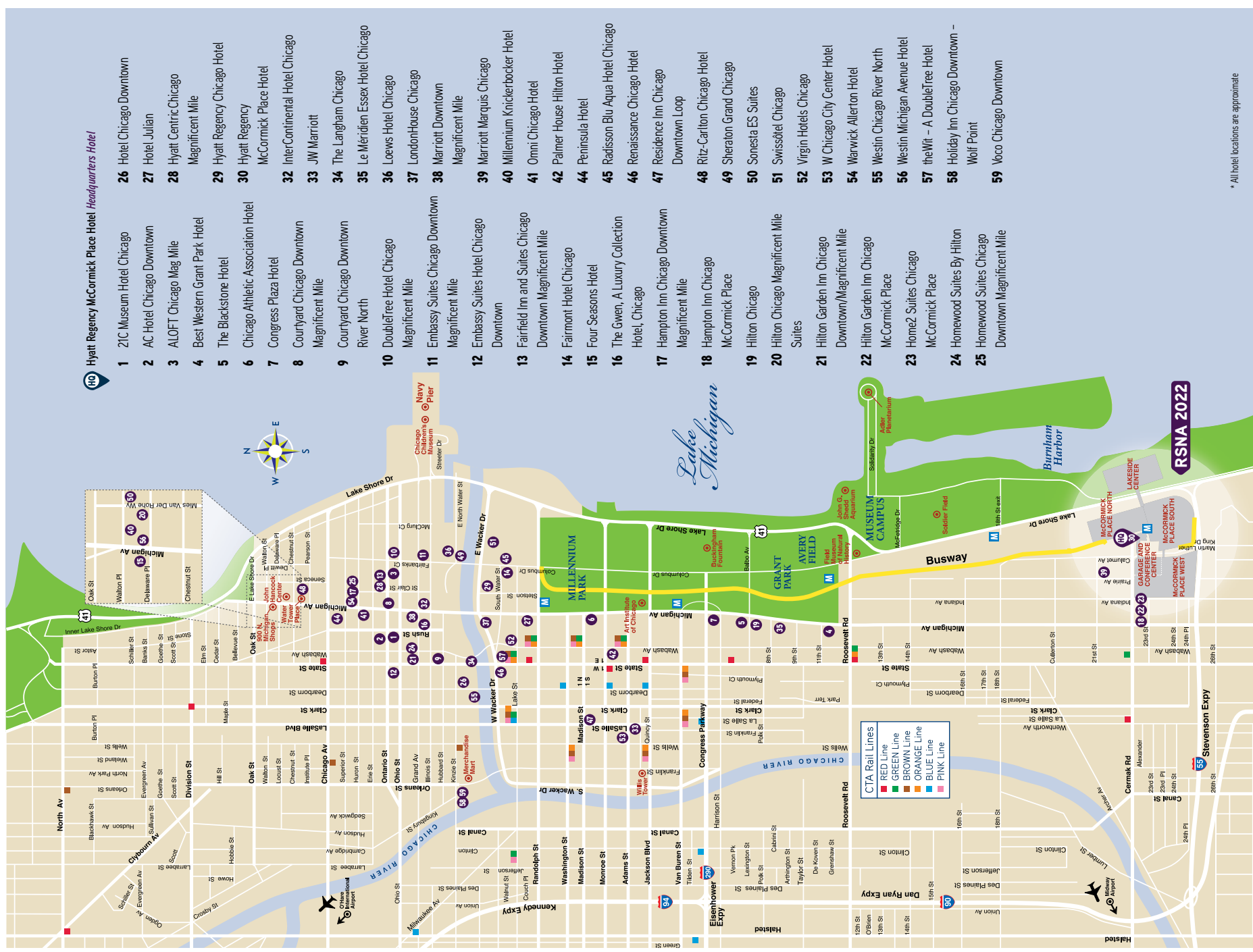

Van Buren Street Station is below ground on Michigan Avenue between Jackson and Van Buren Streets. Street access is on Michigan Avenue at the northeast, northwest and southwest corners at Van Buren Street.
- **Museum Campus/11<sup>th</sup> Street station**  
Museum Campus/11<sup>th</sup> Street Station is on Michigan Avenue at 11<sup>th</sup> Street with street access on the east side of Michigan Avenue on the 11<sup>th</sup> Street bridge.
- **McCormick Place station**  
The station within McCormick Place is underground and accessible from the west side of the Grand Concourse, Level 2.5. Look for the Metra Information Desk near the entrance.

The Prudential Building on Randolph Street also offers access to Metra trains.

Indoor access to Metra is available via the South Water Street exit, through the Illinois Center, from the following hotels: Hyatt Regency Chicago, Fairmont, Radisson Blu Aqua Hotel and Swissôtel Chicago.

Chicago’s rail system consists of train lines spanning the city and is known as the “L”, short for “elevated” train. In many parts of the world, this system is also referred to as a “subway” or “metro”. The Cermak-McCormick Place Green Line Station offers attendees an additional way to leave the McCormick Place campus with stops convenient for those staying in hotels south of the Chicago River. The Cermak-McCormick Place Green Line Station is located at 12 E. Cermak Rd. (between State St. and Wabash Ave.), two blocks northwest of the West Building, Gate 41.
