June is Men's Health Month.

Abdominal aortic aneurysm or triple A is a relatively common condition that can lead to sudden death among older male smokers.

Smoking, high cholesterol, high blood pressure and a family history of triple A can increase your risk for the condition.

Men between the ages of 65 and 75 who have smoked should undergo a one-time ultrasound screening test. Triple A is highly treatable when detected early.
