September is Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month.

Ovarian cancer is a leading cause of cancer-related death in American women, largely because early symptoms often go undiagnosed. There is no routine screening test for ovarian cancer. Your doctor may use pelvic exam, ultrasound or blood tests to diagnose any unexplained symptoms.

Obesity, increasing age and a personal or family history of breast or ovarian cancer may increase your risk.
