May is American Stroke Month.

Stroke is a leading cause of death and permanent brain injury. Black and Hispanic Americans have the highest risk for stroke.

Stroke can be treated when you see the signs. Watch for sudden weakness or numbness, trouble seeing, walking, or speaking, and unexplained sudden, severe headache.

Immediate treatment can reduce your risk of death or permanent injury.

Remember – get help as soon as you see the signs.
