Nominees Announced for 2025 Board of Directors

RSNA has announced two candidates for the 2025 RSNA Board of Directors. Anne Covey, M.D., is a candidate for an at-large director position. Dr. Covey is an interventional radiologist and professor of radiology in New York City at Weill Cornell Medical College and an attending radiologist at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, where she has practiced since 2000.

Tina Young Poussaint, M.D., is a candidate for a standing director position. Dr. Poussaint is the radiologist-in-chief and the Lionel W. Young Chair of the Department of Radiology at Boston Children's Hospital (BCH). She is a professor of radiology at the Harvard Medical School (HMS). Before joining BCH as an attending neuroradiologist in 1993, Dr. Poussaint was an attending neuroradiologist at Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH). [Applications are now open](#) for a Clinical Trials Methodology Workshop, January 4-10, 2025, at Hilton Santa Monica Hotel and Suites. Attendees will learn to develop protocols for the clinical evaluation of imaging modalities during the six-day workshop. Each trainee will be expected to develop a protocol for a clinical study, ready to include in an application for external funding. Participants will be selected through a competitive application process.
