June is Men's Health Month.

Abdominal aortic aneurysm, also known as triple A, is a relatively common condition among older male smokers that can lead to sudden death.

A family history of triple A, smoking, high cholesterol and high blood pressure can increase your risk for the condition.

Men between the ages of 65 and 75 who have smoked should undergo a one-time ultrasound screening test. With early detection, the condition is highly treatable.
